CELTA is an initial qualification for people with little or no previous teaching experience and opens up a whole world of exciting teaching opportunities. As the qualification is awarded by Cambridge ESOL, part of the world-famous University of Cambridge, you can rely on its quality and recognition.

## Who is CELTA for?

People starting a career in English language teaching. You may be considering a career in English language teaching and view CELTA as an entry into a good teaching position in another country. Alternatively, you may be a graduate wanting a qualification which provides a concrete foundation in the fundamentals of language teaching practice.

People looking for a career change or career break. Increasingly, CELTA candidates are professionals, either looking for a new career opportunity or wanting a short break in their existing career.

People teaching English who want to work in Further, Adult, and Community Education in England and Wales. CELTA is also the first phase of the Level 5 Diploma in teaching English (ESO) in the Lifelong Learning Sector.

## What does CELTA involve?
