- Managing learner diversity

Language Analysis and Awareness

- Understanding the structure and systems of English
- Analyzing language for teaching purposes
- Developing error correction techniques

Language Skills: Reading, Listening, Speaking, and Writing

- Developing skills in teaching all four language skills
- Integrating skills in the classroom
- Selecting appropriate materials and resources

Planning and Resources for Different Contexts

- Developing lesson plans and teaching materials
- Using technology in the classroom
- Adapting teaching to different contexts (e.g., one-to-one, small groups, large classes)

Teaching Practice

- Observing experienced teachers
- Planning, delivering, and reflecting on teaching
- Receiving and implementing feedback
- Developing classroom management skills

Assessment

The CELTA course is assessed through a combination of:

- Assignments
- Teaching practice
- Written tests
