Bad Behaviour Policy

At MC Academy, we do not allow bad behaviour!

Abusive (adjective)

People are abusive when they are very rude and violent towards other people.

Example: She was very abusive and swore at her classmate.

Racist (adjective)

People are racist when they think that one race or nationality is better than the other. Example: He was racist because he hates people from different countries.

Homophobic (adjective)

People are homophobic when they treat homosexual (attracted to people of the same gender) people differently.

Example: They are homophobic because they talk badly about homosexual people.

Sexist (adjective)

People are sexist when they treat one of the genders (men or women) differently.

Example: He was sexist and told me that men are better than women.

Religiously Intolerant (adjective phrase)

People are religiously intolerant when they don't accept people who have different religion.

Example: She doesn't talk to me because of my religion.
